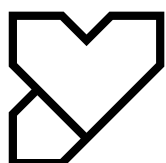

Managing My Money

Session Guides



YOUTH
FOR CHRIST

DRIFT**Celebrity salaries**

Display the celebrity names from M:8 and ask participants to guess their approximate income for 2020, then reveal answers.

BIG PICTURE**Money in society**

This session explores how money can be linked to status and identity.

CASE STUDIES**Pay check**

Using M:9 ask participants to connect the job roles to their average salaries. Read out the answers and explore together if any of them are surprising.

- Q.** Should all jobs be paid the same salary?
- Q.** Is it fair that the celebrities listed in the Drift activity have the amount of money that they do?
- Q.** Why do you think some jobs are paid more than other?

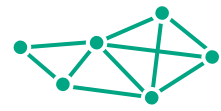
DRIVING QUESTION

Q. Why and how can money be connected to our status and identity?

CORE**What do you value?**

Using M:10 ask participants to rate each thing listed between 0 and 10.

- Q.** Can these things be ranked?
- Q.** Do some affect the others?



A DISCUSS

Money or fame

- Q.** If a footballer was only paid £400 a month, would people still want to be footballers?
- Q.** If a famous singer or band were paid minimum wage, would people still want to apply for reality TV singing competitions?
- Q.** Why do you think this?
- Q.** What is more attractive, money or fame? Why?

B CREATE

Desert island items

Ask participants to imagine they are on a desert island with basic food, drink, clothes and shelter. Ask them to draw five things that they would take with them. Then share ideas and explore their reasons why.

C ACTIVATE

Would you rather

Using M:11 play a game of Would You Rather, where participants stand on one side of the room for one answer and the other side of the room for the other. Use these as discussion prompts.

DEMONSTRATE

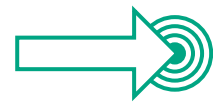
All about me

Using M:12 ask participants to draw themselves (or use the outline) and write things about themselves around the outside either using the prompts or with their own ideas. Once they've done this, ask them to draw a £ sign next to all of the things that are affected by money and discuss this.

INVIGORATE

Telephone game

Write down a phrase and show it to the first participant who whispers it to the person next to them. This continues until you reach the last person who says out loud what they've heard. Show the group what was originally written down.



A CHALLENGE

Money and identity

Q. How does the amount of money you have affect your self-esteem?

B WILD CARD

Real worth

Q. Are there some things that you can't put a price on?

ACHIEVE

Encouragement

Give each participant a piece of paper and ask them to write their name on the top. Pass the papers around and ask the rest of the group to write encouraging things about the person that have nothing to do with money.

PROVE IT

What's important

Using M:13, ask participants to choose two things from their M:12 activity (one with a £ sign, and one without). Ask them to explain why that thing is important to them.

REFLECT

Participants to complete and discuss the following three statements about the session, following examples from the tutor if required:

1. Today I enjoyed...
2. Today I learnt...
3. A question I still have is...

These allow the participants to reflect on what they have learnt in the session, what they enjoyed the most and what they might like to do more of next time. This will help you to assess understanding and inform future preparation.

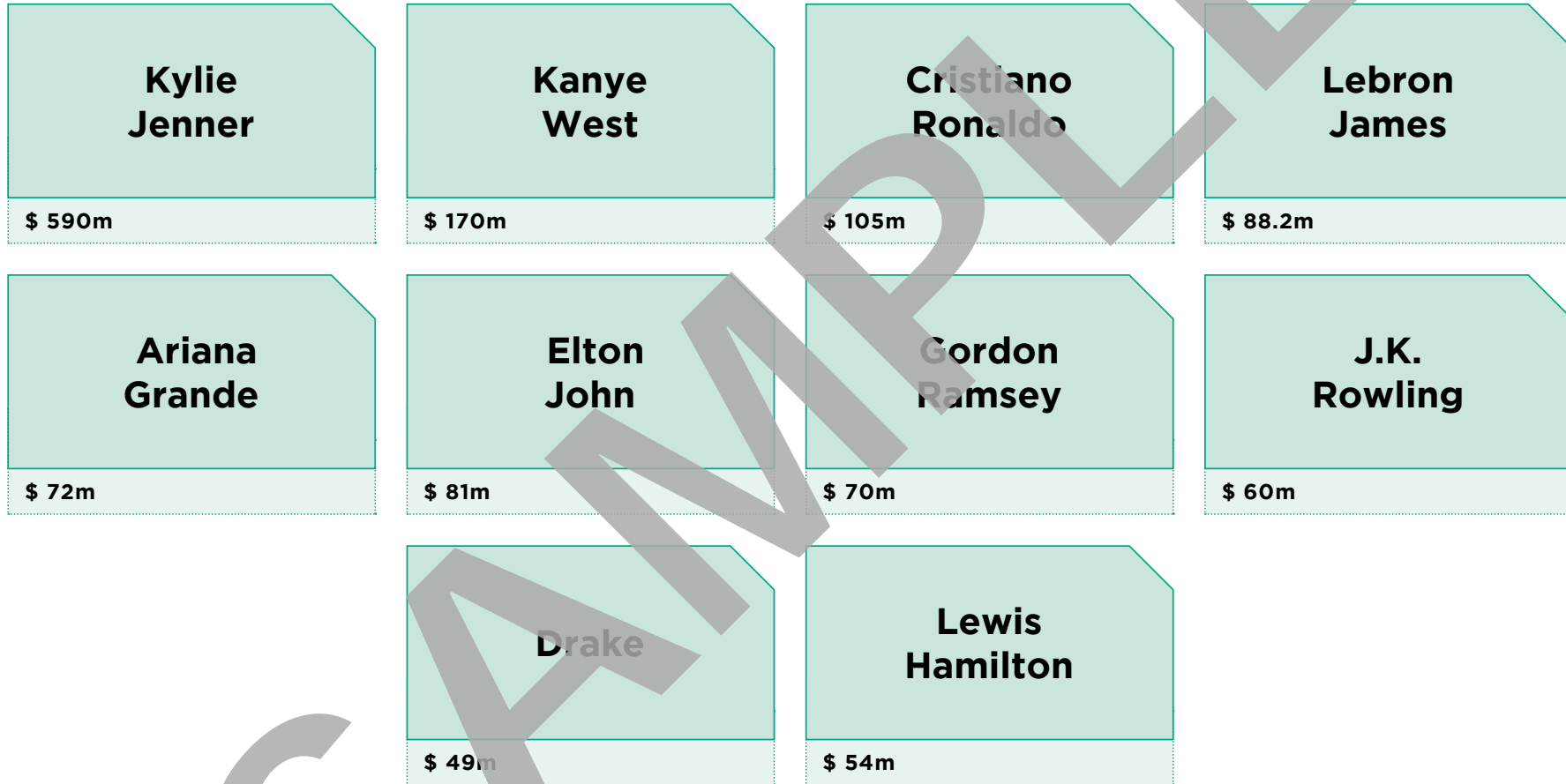

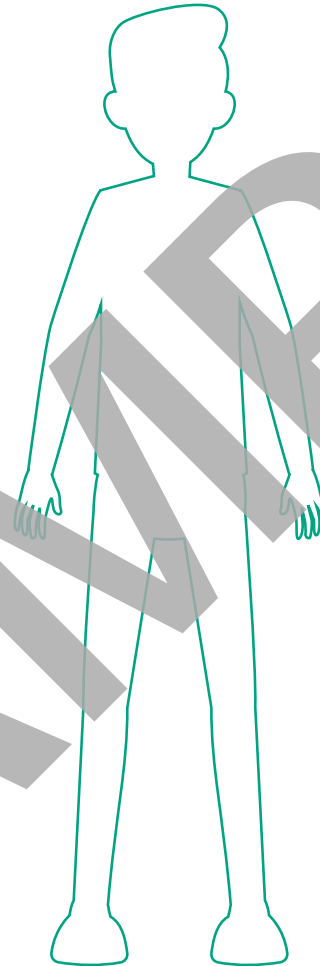
